The Swarovski Crystal was created by Daniel Swarovski in 1862. This wonderful glass has been lead-free since 2012 and of course the formula is strictly secret.

Daniel Swarovski was a jeweler and glass cutter.

In 2004 Swarovski created a crystal star over 2.5 meters in diameter, weighing nearly 250 kg.
